INVITATION TO PUBLIC HEARINGS ON EVIDENCE LAW

The Australian Law Reform Commission's Interim Report on Evidence was tabled recently in Federal Parliament. It is available from Australian Government Publishing Service Bookshops around Australia. It contains detailed proposals for the reform of evidence law together with a draft Evidence Bill.
