Case Flow Management - Alice Springs

The attendance of Judges at Alice Springs is regular, but there is no permanent judicial presence.

Case flow management has not been able to be implemented in a manner satisfactory to the Court, despite the endeavours of those concerned. The Court is determined that the system will be entrenched and continued in accordance with 0.48.

The Master and Registrar have been authorised to take over the present system from the Judges and utilise the powers in 0.48 to conduct conference pursuant to that Order by teleconferencing.

Interlocutory applications will also ordinarily now be heard before the Master or Judge if necessary by teleconferencing. This will avoid delays which may have arisen whilst waiting for a Judge to be available in Alice Springs.

Interlocutory applications ordinarily heard by the Master may be heard by a Judge available in Alice Springs at the discretion of the Judge, or if referred to the Judge by the Master.
