### *Filing of Affidavits and Supporting Documentation*

The Administrative Review Council and the Australian Law Reform Commission are conducting a review of Freedom of Information Act (FOI) legislation.

All 1994/95 memberships of The Law Society of the NT will expire on **June 30, 1995.**


