Administrative Law Prize & Copyright Law Prize

The Centre for International and Public Law at the Australian National University announces details of the two above-named prizes.

The *AIAL (Australian Institution of Administrative Law) Prize in Administrative Law* attracts a prize of \$2000 which will be awarded to the author of an essay displaying original thinking on a topic of the author's choice relating to administrative law. The essay should be 8,000 - 10,000 words in length and the closing date for the prize is 1 March 1997. The winning entry will be determined by the Executive of the Institute and will be published by the Institute.

The *1997 GC O'Donnell Copyright Essay Prize* is awarded in honour of Gus O'Donnell, founder of the Australian Copyright Council.

The prize will be awarded to the author of an essay displaying original thinking on a topic of the author's choice, relating to copyright and the protection of the interests of others.

The \$3000 prize will be adjudged by the Trustees of the GC O'Donnell Biennial Prize Trust and will be published in the *Copyright Reporter*, journal of the Copyright Society of Australia. Closing date for entries is 1 May 1997.
