The MA in Legislative Studies at Hull provides a unique programme of research training and substantive courses on Legislative and Law-making processes.

As a Parliamentary Research As-

sistant officer in the Speaker's office, my training in Legislative Studies will enhance my professional skills and will be an indispensable human resource asset to the National Assembly of Cameroon, now in dire need of trained, qualified and specialised staff poised to ensure the progressive achievement and consolidation of its democratic goals.

As a traditional ruler, the experiences that I will acquire from the UK will enrich my perspective of development and lead me to a deeper appreciation of the dynamics, complexities and opportunities of enterprise work. On my return, I hope to use the knowledge gained in advancing sustainable and viable development in the community I administer.

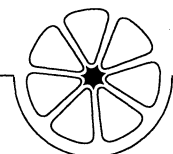
