


The family law CLE presentation planned for June will now be delayed until later in the year in view of expected changes to legislation.

Monday 6 July: Mr Christopher Symes, School of Law and School of Commerce, Flinders University will present a seminar on **insolvency**. Further details to be advised.




NT Women Lawyers' Association will meet for drinks at 5pm on the third Thursday of each month at *Kitty* O'Shea's.

Environmental Defenders' Office (NT)

The EDO requires a full-time lawyer who will be responsible for providing legal advice, conducting litigation, liaising with community groups including environment and Aboriginal organisations, carrying out public education and promoting law reform.

Applicants must hold or be eligible for a full practising certificate in the NT, have the capacity to undertake the listed tasks and have an interest in environmental protection. Salary is up to \$40,000 plus benefits (including 6 weeks annual leave).
