

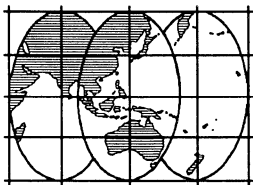
Intellectual Property Law Conference

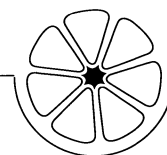
