Scholarships for Young Lawyers

The Inter-Pacific Bar Association has announced the establishment of five M.S. Lin Scholarships for attendance at the Inter-Pacific Bar Association's Tenth Annual Meeting and Conference to be held in Vancouver, Canada from 28 April to 2 May 2000.

The IPBA Council established this scholarship to honour the memory of M.S. Lin, one of the founders of the IPBA.

Young lawyers who are engaged in cross-border practice or who would like to be engaged in cross-border practice, and who would not otherwise be able to attend the Bangkok conference and eligible to apply.

Scholarship application forms must be forwarded to the IPBA Secretariat in Tokyo by 26 November 1999.

To be eligible applicants must be:

1. Under 35 years of age and have less than five years of practice;
2. Be fluent in both written and spoken English;
3. Have an active role in the legal community in their countries;
4. Currently be involved in cross-border practice or who would like to become involved in cross-border practice;
5. Have published an article in a reputable journal;
6. Preference will be given to those applicants who could not otherwise attend the conference, for example, because of financial circumstances.
