Criminal lawyers' Bali conference

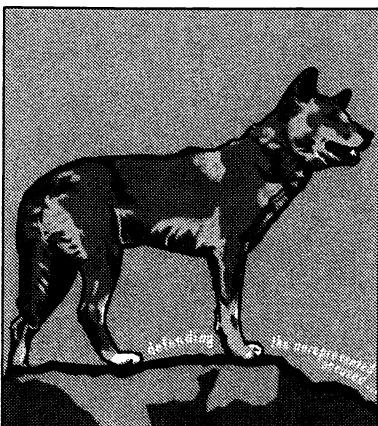
The following dates are a must for your diary: 29 June to 5 July 2003.

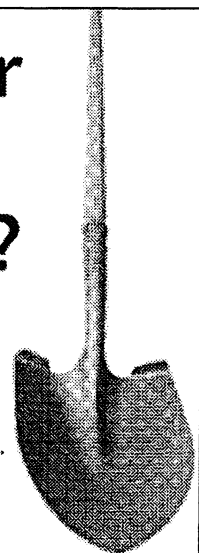
