Calling New Authors

The Society is always looking for new contributors to *Balance*, particularly when their articles have a Territory significance. We recognise that practitioners are often time poor however you can turn this to your advantage by authoring an article that attracts CPD points.


Practitioners may earn up to six CPD points per CPD year by simply by writing a legal article and having it published in *Balance*.

Below are key critera for earning CPD points as a *Balance* author.

 For each 1000 words of a published legal article or work in a recognised legal publication or other quality non-legal publication, structural editing of legal material and the refereeing of a legal article - 1 CPD point.

- CPD points may not be claimed in respect of a publication that deals with substantially the same content as a presentation for which CPD points have been claimed.
- A maximum of six CPD points may be claimed under this category.
