

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

Manuscripts

The *Griffith Law Review* welcomes contributions of previously unpublished work, including articles, review essays, case notes and book reviews. All submissions other than book reviews will be subjected to a peer review process before publication. Intending contributors should submit a printed copy and a disk copy (preferably in the latest Word for Windows format) to the address below. They must also ensure that their submissions conform to the Style Guide, which can be found at www.gu.edu.au/blr.

The Editors request that authors give the *Griffith Law Review* an exclusive option to publish their contribution for one month from the date it is received: the Editors will use their best endeavours to advise authors within that period whether the piece has been accepted for publication or not.

All submissions must be in English using the *Australian Oxford English Dictionary* spelling throughout, except where quotations demand otherwise.

Disk and Hard Copies

Disks should be in Microsoft Word or RTF format. Hard copies should be double spaced on one side of A4 paper, with a 5 cm left margin. Both electronic and hard copy versions *must* be supplied.

Length

Not normally to exceed 7000 words.

Language

It is the *Griffith Law Review*'s policy that non-sexist language be used in all articles it publishes.
