

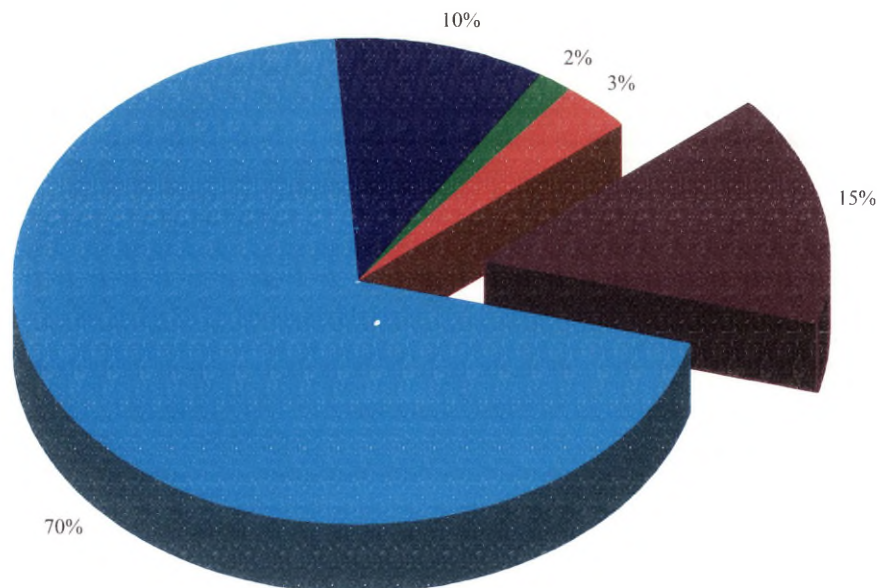

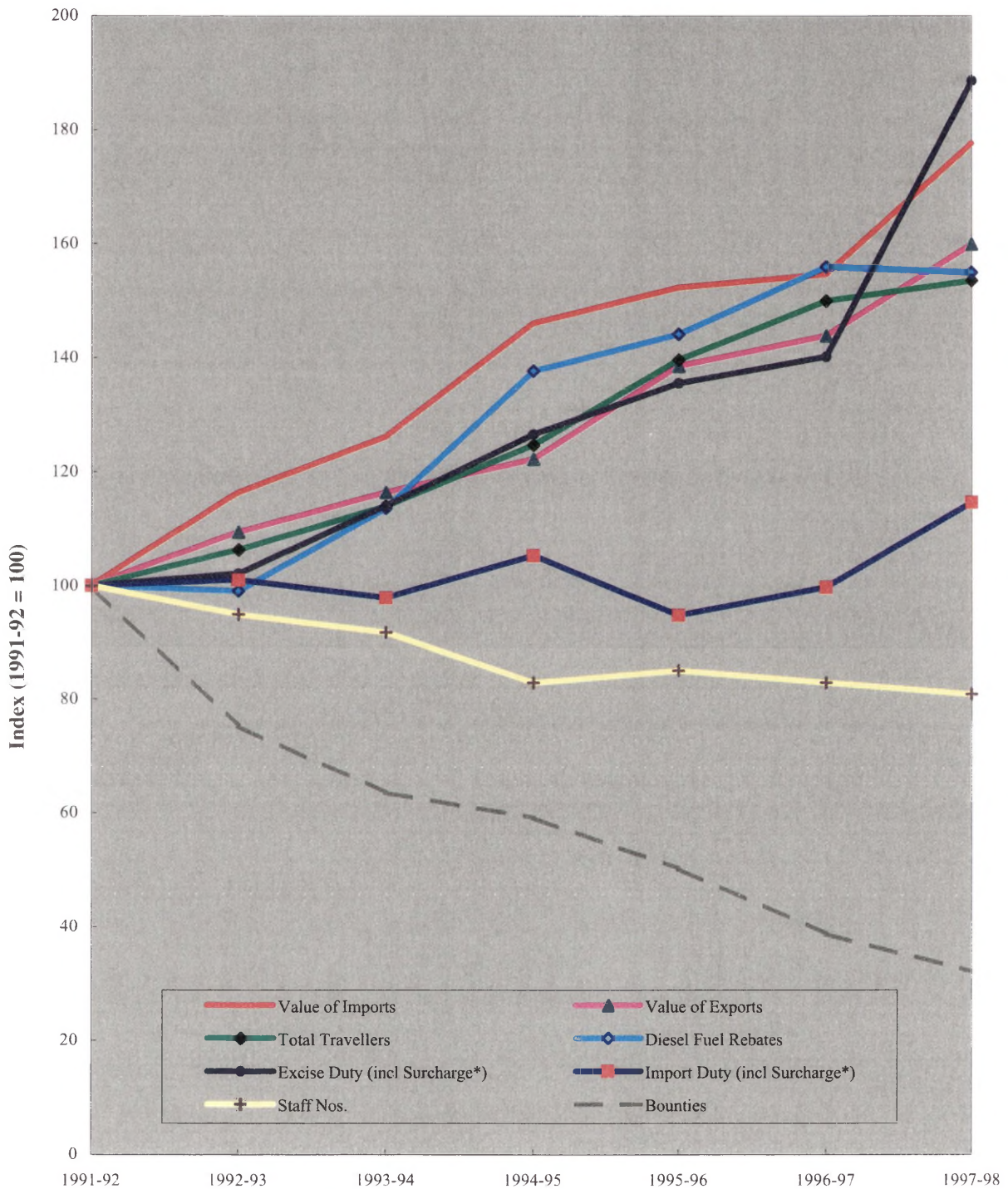
Sources of Commonwealth Government Revenue:
