



Opening of 31 West Chambers Level 31, Santos Place, 32 Turbot Street Friday 20 August 2010, 5pm

The Hon Paul de Jersey AC Chief Justice

I am very pleased to have been invited to open these fine new chambers.

One source of personal pleasure is my long-standing friendships with some of the members. Ian Hanger and I, for example, go back to the Ansett Building in the early 1970's: now the Ibis Hotel. Some of you then experienced the name change from MLC to Hitachi, and now your peregrinations have led to these superb premises.

Another source of pleasure is one I share with all my judicial colleagues, and that is our satisfaction in witnessing the evolution of a distinctive legal precinct at this end of George Street, a legal precinct elegantly complemented by some impressive commercial outlets.
