New WA appointment

Mrs Elizabeth Spoor, BA, DipLib, has been appointed Divisional Librarian: Administration Services of the University of Western Australia Library, Mrs Spoor has worked in libraries since 1960 and was formerly Circulation Librarian at the WAIT Library after previously being the Acquisitions Librarian.

In 1980 Mrs Spoor spent 3 months study leave in Ontario, Canada examining the automated systems in operation in four academic libraries to see how the systems had changed library operations. Last year she completed the Graduate Diploma in Business and Administration at WAIT. In December she gave a paper at VALA '83: Second National Conference on Library Automation, entitled 'Management Information from Library Systems.

The College of Library and Information Services, University of Maryland, is planning the eighteenth annual Library Administrators Development Program, to be held May 6-18, 1984. As in the past, participants will include senior administrative personnel of large library systems public, research, academic, special, governmental, and school - from North America and abroad.

Theological collections listed

A project to uncover the thousands of periodical titles held in Australian and New Zealand theological libraries has recently been brought to completion by Hans Arns and Marianne Dacey.

In 200 pages it lists the holdings of 80 libraries of all denominations in the South Pacific region and it should come as no surprise that many of these libraries and their unique periodicals have not yet found a place in SALSSAH. The scarcity of this type of journal in Academic and State libraries will make this Union list an essential companion to SALSSAH in Australian reference collections.


News in brief
