Newcastle's central library

Staff and users of the central library of the Newcastle Region are enjoying their spacious and enlarged premises, with all stock under one roof for the first time in many years.

Remodelling has recently been completed of the Newcastle War Cultural Centre, which, when first opened in 1957; housed the library, the City Art Gallery and a branch of the NSW Conservatorium.

The building is now used exclusively as a library, with the ground floor housing the lending section, including substantial areas for talking and Braille books, toys and children's craftwork. The Reference/information section and a theatrette are on the extended mezzanine/first floor, and the second floor contains the local history section, rare books and dark room, as well as being used for book storage. The administrative offices, workrooms for cataloguing and staff amenities areas are on the third floor.
