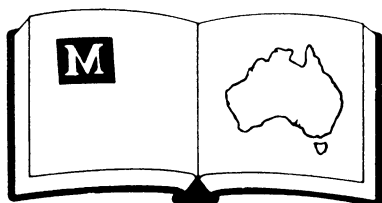


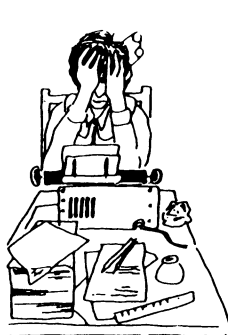

Major Adelaide libraries (No ISBN) is a 15-page booklet produced by SALAC (South Australian Library Advisory Committee), 44 Pirie Street, Adelaide 5000. Addresses, hours of operation, subject strengths, access policies. Minor in size, but major in usefulness.

A list of published works of Frederick Wood Jones 1879—1954 (No ISBN yet) is a projected new edition of Barry E. Christophers' 1974 work on the noted anatomist and zoologist. It will be a limited edition, and prospective subscribers should write to Dr Christophers at 377 Church Street, Richmond, Vic 3121.

Choosing educational software (ISBN 0 87287 388 9) by Carol Truett and Lori Gillespie is an attempt to grapple with an avalanche of software engulfing teachers everywhere where the mighty micro rules. Background, how to evaluate software, sources of software (all North American, I think), organisations and periodicals (ditto). Published earlier this year by Libraries Unlimited at US\$18.50. Copy supplied by Bennetts.

Online information retrieval systems: an introductory manual to principles and practice (ISBN 0 85157 363 0), by Bernard Houghton and John Convey, is now in its second edition. 200-odd pages of basic introduction, together with a substantial section serving as a practical description of six systems widely used in the UK (4 of them are fairly widely used in Australia too). Published in this anno mirabilis by Bingley at £11.50. Review copy supplied by Bennetts.

Thesaurus of ERIC descriptors (ISBN 0 89774 073 4), 10th edition, 1984. Indexing terms used by the Educational Resources Information Center for the ERIC database, its printed and online products, and, by the way, the *Australian education index*. Fine example of how to compile a thesaurus. Essential if you ever have to call on ERIC for help. Published earlier this year by Oryx Press. Review copy supplied by Bennetts. US\$45.00.

A handbook of comparative librarianship (ISBN 0 85157 348 7), another stayer, now in its third edition. Editor Monique MacKee presents a 'comprehensive and systematic guide to sources for students of comparative librarianship'. Shows the need for scalpel and/or graft in places: e.g. STISEC but no Horton, Munn-Barr but no Munn-Pitt that I could find. An essential sourcebook still. Published by Bingley last year; review copy supplied by guess who and comparatively cheap at £35.00.

Global action networks (ISBN 3 598 21858 3; ISSN 0084-3814) is the perhaps hyperbolic title of volume three of the 20th edition of Yearbook of international organizations, 1983-84. Classified by subject, from abattoir to zymurgy, combinations of subjects and regions. Can be used effectively by itself (DM 248.00) or as volume three of the set (DM 980.00). Published by Saur and available locally from Bennetts.

World guide to scientific associations and learned societies (ISBN 3 598 20522 8) published earlier this year by Saur, massive (947 pages), extensive (22,000 organizations in 150 countries). Still lists the LAA at Clarence Street, but it's nice nonetheless to be regarded as either scientific or learned. Good subject and initialism lists. A substantial work at a substantial price. DM 268.00.
