

## INTERNATIONAL STAFF EXCHANGES

From time to time *InCite* contains lists of overseas library staff who wish to exchange positions with their Australian counterparts. Many of these names are forwarded by Libex, The Bureau for International Staff Exchange in Wales.

Libex was established in January 1983 and is based at the College of Librarianship, Wales. It aims to assist exchanges between library staff in the USA, Canada, the EEC countries, Australia and New Zealand.

Australian library staff wishing to exchange places with someone overseas should complete a form giving details of the job they wish to receive and return it to Libex. These forms are available either from Louise Lansley at the LAA, 376 Jones Street, Ultimo NSW 2007 or from Libex College of Librarianship, Wales, Llanbadarn Fawr, Aberystwyth, Dyfed, SY23 3AS, Wales U.K.

An abstract of the details on the form is then placed in journals of librarianship in the country in which the exchange is required. Persons writing in response to abstracts are sent a copy of the original form and are asked to contact the originator of the form if they wish to pursue the exchange.

## Research Centre Fellowships 1986

As part of its policy of fostering research, the Council of the Australian War Memorial is sponsoring a scheme of fellowships for projects related to the intellectual organization of the Memorial's library, archival and audio-visual collections.

It is expected that the fellowships will attract librarians, archivists, audio-visual media specialists and other persons interested in compiling guides or otherwise describing Research Centre collections or in studying the methods and techniques used in acquiring, listing, cataloguing, arranging or using them.

Remuneration for fellows will be at a rate of \$1200 per month for those in receipt of normal salary for the duration of the fellowship and \$2500 per month for those not in receipt of income. Return airfares to Canberra will also be provided.

Fellowships will be available for periods of between three and twelve months and intending applicants should, in the first instance, discuss possible projects with:
