The bibliography has been compiled princ-  
ly from overseas and Australian bibli-  
phic databases accessed by the Library as  
ll as information supplied by the Royal  
tional Institute for the Deaf, Gallaudet Col-  
e (Washington DC) and the International  
eration of Library Associations Working  
up on the Library Needs of the Deaf.

includes such items as *How the library  
y be used with deaf children to the best ad-  
vantage* and *Difficulties of the reading dis-  
ed* from Australian sources; and *Guidelines  
libraries to serve special patrons* and *Res-  
sibilities of the public library to the deaf  
sumer*; from the United States material.

With the development of library services to

### Australian Leisure Index 1985

Compiled by ACHPIRST (Australian Clearing House for Publications in Recreation, Sport and Tourism), this is an index (with some abstracts) to over 3,000 Australian publications within the following subject areas:

thirty-nine individual sports • physical education • exercise rehabilitation • physical fitness • exercise • diet and health • coaching • leisure • recreation • recreational reserves and parks • movement and performing arts • travel and tourism. Aspects of the subject include administration, management, communication, planning, psychology, history, statistics, facilities, equipment, sociology, medicine and science.

Since 1982, the *Australian Leisure Index* has recorded over 10,000 Australian publica-  
tions.
