Wednesday 2 July: Breakfast: 7:30am at the Travelodge Hotel for Status of Women in Librarianship. \$6.00 per person.

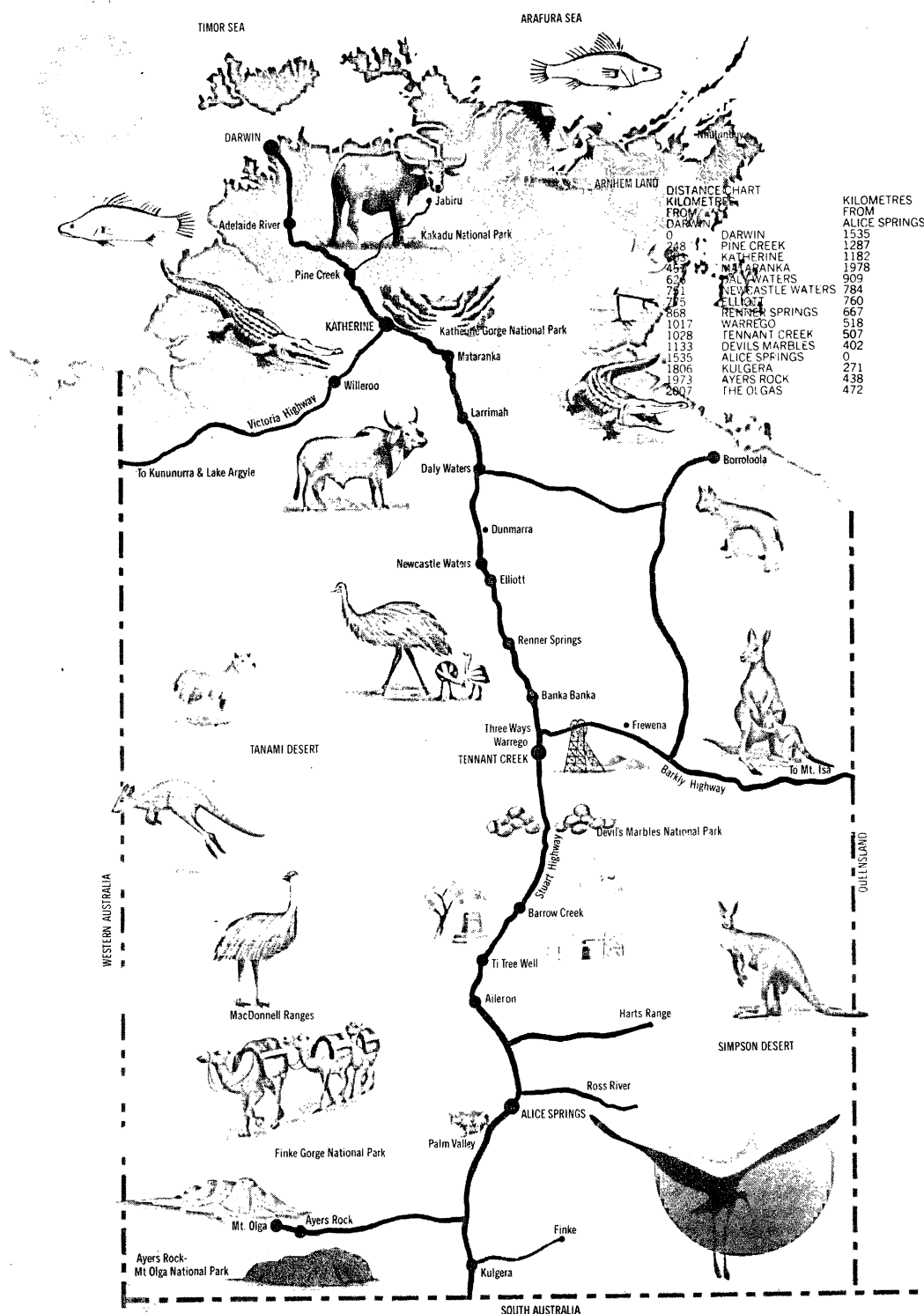

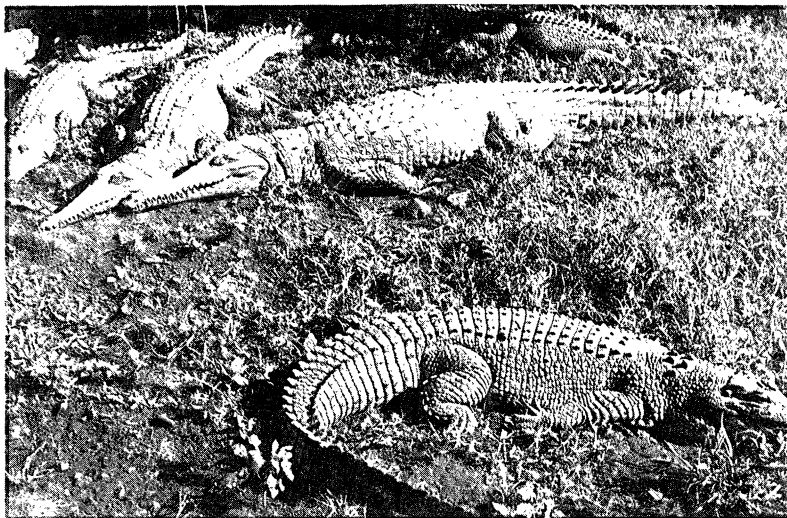
