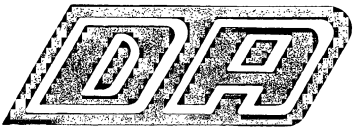

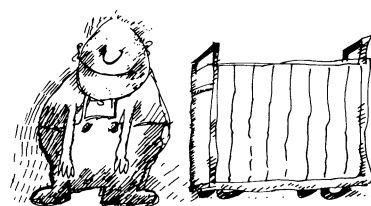

The Commonwealth Department of Health invites applications from suitably qualified persons for the position of Librarian, Class 2, in the Corporate Resources Division.

The duties of this position will be to control the acquisition and collection development unit of the Central Library including the processing and cataloguing of serials. Select titles for inclusion into collection. Prepare financial estimates for library services. Evaluate collections for their use or disposal. Oversee the compilation of departmental and other online lists of serials. The acquisition unit is currently being computerised using the DOBIS/LIBIS software system on IBM mainframes.

Suitably qualified persons would need to possess an appropriate degree or diploma together with training in librarianship and be eligible for professional membership of the Library Association of Australia; or a recognised course of integrated study in librarianship and academic subjects; or other appropriate qualification. Persons who have not completed degree or diploma studies listed above but who are qualified for admission to Associate Membership of Library Association of Australia under the conditions applying to 31 December 1980 and who are able to produce evidence of experience, additional study or personal aptitude may apply.

The successful applicant will be permanently appointed to the Australian Public Service with conditions of service including four weeks annual leave with bonus payment, cumulative paid sick leave, three months long service leave after ten years continuous service and a contributory superannuation scheme. Fares and removal expenses to take up duty and a short term accommodation allowance may also be provided in some circumstances.

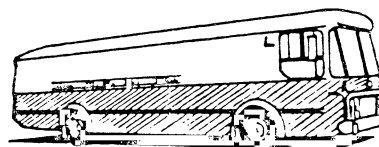
