


WHO'S WHERE

The National Library recently appointed Ms Susanne Bruhn, as its new Chief Librarian, Library Services for People with Disabilities Section, (formerly Library Services for Disabled People Section).



From 1977 to 1985, Ms Bruhn worked at the State Library and Printing House for the Blind, Denmark. She was in charge of its Acquisitions/Cataloguing Section from 1979, and from 1982 was also responsible for its Talking Book and Recording Section. During this time Ms Bruhn was active in developing national co-operation, resource sharing and standards. She initiated the development of national standards for talking books and their implementation by all producers in Denmark and achieved the inclusion of audio books for the blind in the Danish National

Bibliography of Recorded Sound.

Prior to this appointment, Ms Bruhn worked for 12 months in the National Library of Australia's Oral History Section.

- Jerelynn Emerson Brown has been appointed Bibliographic Services Manager, NSW TAFE Library Services and is now based at the Technical Services Branch at Parramatta. Following her return in July from a stint in the USA Mrs Brown was employed by TAFE as Consultant, Collection Department and most recently as assistant to the Head, TAFE Library Services.

Previously Mrs Brown was a director of the James Bennett Group, Library Supplies.

Monash Uni — cutting costs with CD-ROM

Monash University in Melbourne is now using the CD-ROM ERIC educational reference system. The system was recently installed by the Faculty of Education for use by its staff and higher degree students.

Melbourne based Australian Laser Disk Information Services Pty. Ltd. (ALDIS), an associate company of CLSI Australia, supplied the database system.

The Silver Platter CD-ROM version of ERIC (Educational Resources Information Centre) was chosen by the Education Faculty to reduce online computer searching cost.

The ERIC system not only eliminates online running costs, but also the time restrictions on students using the database for research. It enables users to search both subject matter fields and non-subject matter

fields (author names, institutions names) as well as browse through the dictionary of available index terms and to interact with initial outputs.

More than 200,000 pages of information are contained in the ERIC system which is gleaned from over 775 major education-related serials/periodicals and stored on three separate discs. These contain all the records, indexes and software necessary for full use. The system is updated quarterly.

ALDIS Managing Director, Mr Kim Jelbart, said the ERIC system and other CD-ROM products were a boon to cutting down research time for data in both universities and business. 'The user can perform all the search tasks available through the printed reference tools and most of the search tasks possible on online systems without the connection and communications costs.'
