

IFLA/LAA 88 ON WHEELS

Delegates to LAA/IFLA 88 or IFLA 88 (preferably non-Sydney residents) are invited to put on their joggers and get out the Kodak on Wednesday, 31 August and join in a number of tours taking in libraries throughout the Sydney environs.

Delegates can register for the tour of their choice at the Library Tours Information Desk by the Registration Area, Round House, University of NSW. The tours will start at 9.00 am sharp at the University of NSW, unless otherwise stated on library tour ticket and finish around 4.30 pm in the city.

Historic city tour

This will take you to the State Library of NSW, the Art Gallery of NSW, the Royal Australian Historical Society, the Royal College of Physicians and the Sydney Opera House. The tour will be on foot.

Head North

The north-west suburbs of Sydney will be covered on this bus tour. Places of interest will be Kuring-gai CAE, Macquarie University, Australian Film, Television and Radio School libraries. Please note that this tour will travel north over the Harbour Bridge and

return over the Gladesville Bridge taking in historic Hunters Hill.

Universities and colleges

On this tour travel will be by foot and by bus. Libraries at University of Technology, Sydney Technical College, University of NSW and University of Sydney will be covered. Tourist areas such as Darling Harbour and the Power House Museum will be visited.

Special libraries and the CBD

This tour will include libraries at the Australian Museum; Institute of Chartered Accounts in Australia and a choice of law, finance and other libraries in the Sydney CBD. There will be a stop at Mrs Macquarie's Chair, Hyde Park Barracks and the Mint Building.

Public libraries

The bus will take you to Stanton Library, North Sydney and Willoughby Municipal Library where you will see the computerised Shorelink system at work. This tour will travel over the Sydney Harbour Bridge,

around the northern Harbour suburbs to Manly. Delegates can opt to return by ferry or hydrofoil to Circular Quay.

School libraries

Libraries in North Sydney Primary School, Monte Sant Angelo College, Davidson High School and Balgowlah High School will be visited in this bus tour. At Library Services, NSW Department of Education, OASIS library/administration software will be demonstrated. Return by ferry or hydrofoil to Circular Quay optional.

Children's libraries

This tour, by bus, will include such libraries as Campsie Central Library; Bankstown City Library and Parramatta City Library. The bus will take you to the south-west and western suburbs, and to Old Government House at historic Parramatta.

Half day tours are available in the morning or afternoon to the State Library of NSW; the University of NSW; Stanton Library, North Sydney; Waverley Municipal Library; Sydney College of Arts, Balmain; and to the City of Sydney Public Library.
