## C.H. Currey Memorial Fellowship

The Memorial Fellowship has been established by the Library Council of New South Wales 'to promote the writing of Australian history from the original sources'.

The late Dr Currey, whose bequest made the Fellowship possible, was a well known Australian historian who was conscious of the problems of research workers not supported by grants from universities or other bodies.

The amount of the award this year will be \$10 000. It may be divided between two or more applicants. The money may be expended as the recipient sees fit, within the terms of the general intent of Dr Currey. Examples of use are payment for photocopies/typing expenses, or for travel in connection with research.

Application forms are available from the State Librarian, State Library of New South Wales, Macquarie Street, Sydney, 2000.

Closing date is 1 October 1991. An original and two copies of applications are required.

Please note that the judges' decision is final; no correspondence will be entered into. □

## Patricia Ward memorial A lasting symbol in ALIA House

Patricia Ward was a distinguished and delightful member of our profession and our Association, who died in tragic circumstances with her husband in a rail accident last year.

ALIA NSW Branch has now established a 'Patricia Ward Trust Fund' on behalf of the Association.

To date donations to the total of \$2500 have been received. These funds will be used to secure a fitting memorial to our friend and colleague, one who contributed so much to the field of librarianship.

In acknowledgement and appreciation of Patricia's exceptional communication skills a lectern has been commissioned, to be used in the recently completed ALIA National Office conference room. The remaining monies collected will support an on-going series of publications in the areas of Patricia's interests — preservation, conservation, school libraries, public libraries, local studies, education and training, archives.
