

1994 Churchill Fellowships for overseas study

THE CHURCHILL TRUST invites applications from Australians of 18 years and over from all walks of life who wish to be considered for a Churchill Fellowship to undertake, during 1994, an overseas study project that will enhance their usefulness to the Australian community.

No prescribed qualifications are required—merit is the primary criterion, whether based on past achievements or demonstrated ability for future achievement. Fellowships are awarded annually to those who have already established themselves in their calling. They are not awarded for the purpose of obtaining higher academic or formal qualifications.


and postgraduate degree and diploma courses in Information/Teacher Librarianship.
