The workshop will provide a forum for discussion of these issues. Particular emphasis will be on understanding the library's customers and how to build services which are designed to meet their needs. Strategic and market planning techniques and tools will be used to challenge our ideas on what products and services we deliver, where we deliver them, who to and at what cost — to the library and the customer.
