Australian Library Collections Task Force

he National Library of Australia is convening the Australian Library Collections Task Force. The establishment of the Task Force was recommended by the National Round Table on Access to Overseas Monographs through Australian Libraries. The task force will implement the recommendations of the round table (see http://www.nla.gov.au/niac/ meetings/rtresolutns.html).

The task force comprises academic and representatives from national, state, university, and special libraries.

In consultation with the academic and research community, the task force will investigate and recommend strategies for improving access to overseas material, and is expected to:

- examine the use of overseas materials in particular subject areas, and access to foreign language material;
- identify base-line data to support collection development and access;
- develop mechanisms to extend the percentage of material held on the National Bibliographic Database (NBD);
- · consider interlibrary loan and document delivery issues; and,
- promote user understanding of access mechanisms.
