International lending guidelines

IFLA produces new guidelines for inter-library loan requests by e-mail

he IFLA Office for UAP and International Lending has developed new guidelines which can be used to support the sending of inter-library loan requests by email. While many structured messaging systems require requests to be formatted according to strict rules, many hundreds of 'free-form' inter-library loan requests sent between libraries have no such stricture, and all the elements of the request are given in the body of the e-mail message.

The IFLA Office for International Lending was asked to produce some guidelines to help inter-lending staff to format such requests in a standardised way, which should ensure that all requests contain all of the required elements, and that the information is given in a standard format which will help speed up the processing of such requests.
