ALIANet e-lists now support 'real subscriber names'. If you subscribe to a list via e-mail and your 'real name' is attached to your e-mail address, your name will automatically be added to the e-list. If you subscribe to an e-list via the web, you have the option of adding your name as well as your e-mail address. Either way, you can choose to add or remove your real name at any time, via your e-list subscription management web interface. You can now change your address on one,


National Simultaneous Storytime (NSS) 2004


