Tell us a bit about your group...

The ALIA Top End Group is a small but active group of ALIA members who enjoy getting together both for professional events as well as social ones. Some of our members come to a couple of events a year, others attend more regularly.

What are 3 things you'd like us to know about you?

- ALIA Top End Group is a group of fun people, young and old, from all sectors of the library and information world.

- Members network well and the numbers involved make for an intimate and active group.

- The Group organises a number of professional development activities each year, often using their own expertise, thus keeping the costs low.

What gives your group a sense of purpose and accomplishment?
