Creative Commons

The Creative Commons (CC) provides an alternative licensing system so that authors, musicians, and other creators can grant rights to the public to use their work without payment but still retain control over their copyright material. These licences are becoming more common for resources.

The Economic Development and Infrastructure Committee of the Victorian Government has recommended that Victorian public agencies adopt a uniform licensing system and that CC be used as the default licences for that system. If Victoria implements these recommendations, they'll be in good company: US President Obama, the Australian Bureau of Statistics, and the Australian Broadcasting Corporation all already use CC licences for their material.

Creative Commons for schools

There are a number of licenses under Creative Commons (CC) that allow creators to communicate which rights they reserve and which rights they waive.

Creative Commons licenses

These are the six main Creative Commons licenses and their symbols. They are listed from the least restrictive to the most restrictive license type.

Attribution



This license lets others distribute, remix, tweak, and build upon your work, even commercially, as long as they credit you for the original creation. This is the most accommodating of licenses offered.

Attribution Share Alike



This license lets others remix, tweak, and build upon your work, even for commercial reasons, as long as they credit you and license their new creations under the identical terms. This license is often compared to open source software licenses. All new works based on yours will carry the same license, so any derivatives will also allow commercial use.

Attribution No Derivatives



This license allows for redistribution, commercial, and non-commercial, as long as it is passed along unchanged and in whole, with credit to you.

Attribution Non-Commercial



This license lets others remix, tweak, and build upon your work non-commercially, and although their new works must also acknowledge you and be non-commercial, they don't have to license their derivative works on the same terms.

Attribution Non-Commercial Share Alike



This license lets others remix, tweak, and build upon your work non-commercially, as long as they credit you and license their new

creations under the identical terms. Others can download and redistribute your work just like the by-nc-nd license, but they can also translate, make remixes, and produce new stories based on your work. All new work based on yours will carry the same license, so any derivatives will also be non-commercial in nature.

Attribution Non-Commercial No Derivatives



This license is the most restrictive of our six main licenses, allowing redistribution. This license is often called the 'free advertising' license because it allows others to download your works and share them with others as long as they mention you and link back to you, but they can't change them in any way or use them commercially.

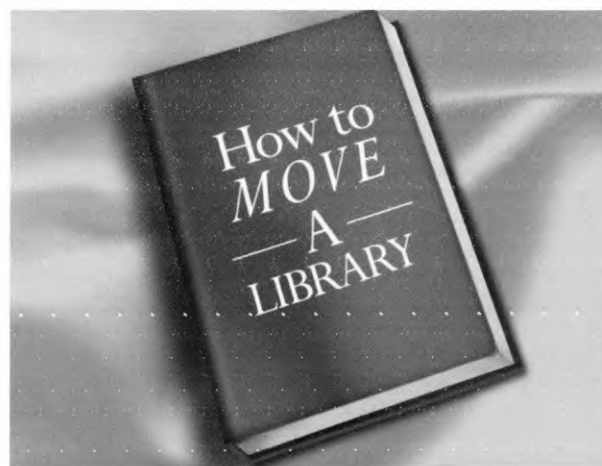
Creative Commons Australia
