Anna Troberg, Charles Leadbeater, and Dick Rijken announced as keynote speakers!

Anna Troberg is an author, the leader of the Swedish Pirate Party, and an avid blogger. Before she became a pirate she used to be the head of the Swedish branch of a Nordic book publishing house. Her comic novel *Bosses from Hell* is published in Sweden, Norway, and Finland.

Charlie Leadbeater is an author, a leading authority on innovation, strategy, and education, and one of the most influential creative people in the world. He has advised companies, cities, and governments, and is former UK Prime Minister Tony Blair's favourite corporate thinker. He is widely recognised as one of the world's leading innovative thinkers on the future of learning, in the developed and the developing world. His renowned work, *Learning from the Extremes*, in conjunction with Cisco, looked at the demand for innovative approaches to low cost, mass forms of education in the developing world.

Dick Rijken is director of STEIM, a lab for electronic live performance, and professor in 'Information Technology and Society' at the 'The Hague University of Applied Sciences' where he researches the changing role of cultural (heritage) institutions in the network society and the possibilities of design thinking in different domains. He also works as an independent consultant for companies and non-profit organisations and as a lecturer and project coach on strategic and conceptual issues in digital communication and design.
