



he Australia's Favourite Library Campaign became bigger than we could have ever imagined! It is certainly crystal clear that Australians love their libraries and all the important services they provide.

The campaign launch for Australia's Favourite Library coincided with Library Lovers' Day in February this year. Members of the public were asked to nominate the libraries they loved by phone, email or online in a range of categories.

We were thrilled to receive 547 nominations for 203 different libraries and library services. Voting launched in the middle of March and we were overwhelmed by the number of votes received – all 223,768 of them!

AUSTRALIA'S FAVOURITE LIBRARY: SANDRINGHAM LIBRARY

Sandringham Library in Victoria received the most votes throughout the campaign, receiving the title of Australia's Favourite Library. It was clear from the beginning how popular Sandringham is, with a flood of nominations coming in from Sandringham Library users. While everyone we heard from was thrilled with the services the library provides, it is the wonderful library workers who make this library truly stand out to its users, as these nominations explain:

'I love the Sandringham Library. The staff is marvelous – especially as I am 84 and often need help. They have introduced me to ebooks and they cater for everybody'.

'Sandringham Library is a great place. Staff are very helpful, knowledgeable and friendly and they go out of their way to assist customers... They have some wonderful programs for adults, children and storytelling'.



And our category winners are:

AUSTRALIA'S FAVOURITE LIBRARY SERVICE: **HUME LIBRARIES**
