The Library Technology Team has played a vital role in the preservation of thousands of texts in dozens of Indigenous languages of the NT. In developing, supporting and hosting the Living Archive of Aboriginal Languages, the team has ensured the survival of this rich set of resources that documents traditional and modern Indigenous life and stories. By making these resources easy accessible through an open access website at cdu.edu.au/laal, the library is enabling new engagements and knowledge-making practices to new audiences both locally and internationally, while modelling good practice in supporting a research project. 




