

RESULTS OF THE 2017 ALIA MEMBERSHIP SURVEY


ALIA has released the results from its 2017 Membership Survey. The report can be accessed by ALIA Members via the Member Centre (bit.ly/2Dkb8UV). Make sure to login to see this Member only report.

Every two years ALIA carries out a membership survey to give all ALIA Members the opportunity to provide feedback. In 2017, the survey took place from 31 July to 28 August. It was similar in content to those carried out in 2015 and 2013, to help the ALIA Board assess changes in Member interests and concerns.

There was a great response to the survey with 748 people participating. Analysis of the responses found that 87% of respondents participated in some form of professional development; 91% of respondents read *INCITE*; 95% of respondents who had been in contact with ALIA staff were either 'satisfied' or 'very satisfied' with the level of service they received; and that the advocacy and lobbying work done by ALIA was seen as the most

important aspect of ALIA's work, closely followed by professional development.
