**A BILL**

FOR

**An Act to amend the *States Grants (Education Assistance—  
Participation and Equity) Act 1983*, and for related  
purposes**

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

**Short title etc.**

5 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *States Grants (Education Assistance—Participation and Equity) Amendment Act (No. 2) 1987*.

(2) In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *States Grants (Education Assistance—Participation and Equity) Act 1983*<sup>1</sup>.

**Commencement**

10 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

**Limits on grants in respect of 1984, 1985, 1986 and 1987**

3. Section 18 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) “\$42,241,000” and substituting “\$42,352,000”.

**Limits on grants under section 20 in respect of 1984, 1985, 1986 and 1987**

4. Section 21 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (4) “\$353,000” and substituting “\$355,000”.

**Limits on grants under section 22A in respect of 1985, 1986 and 1987**

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5. Section 22B of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (3) “\$649,000” and substituting “\$630,000”.

**Schedules**

6. Schedules 10, 11 and 12 to the Principal Act are repealed and the Schedules set out in the Schedule to this Act are substituted.

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**Payments made before Royal Assent**

7. Payments (including advances) by way of financial assistance made to a State or to the Northern Territory under the Principal Act shall be deemed to have been made also for the purposes of the Principal Act as amended by this Act.
