OUTLINE

The purpose of the Bill is to cancel the registration of the Australian Building Construction Employees' and Builders Labourers' Federation ("the Federation") under the Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1904.

FINANCIAL IMPACT STATEMENT

No costs to the Government arise directly from the legislation.

There may be costs to the building industry if the Federation causes industrial disruption after the cancellation of its registration. The Government aims to achieve a significant improvement in industrial relations in the building industry in the longer term resulting in greater efficiency and overall savings.

NOTES ON CLAUSES

CLAUSE 1

This gives the short title of the Bill.

CLAUSE 2

The legislation is to come into operation on Assent.

CLAUSE 3: CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION OF FEDERATION

The registration of the Australian Building Construction Employees' and Builders Labourers' Federation as an organization of employees under the Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1904 is cancelled by force of this provision.
