## OUTLINE

The amendment to the Industrial Chemicals (Notification and Assessment) Amendment Bill (No.2) 1992 specifies an amnesty period of two years for the new category of eligible chemicals.

## FINANCIAL IMPACT

The amendment has no significant financial impact.

## NOTES ON PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Proposed section 20B of clause 8 currently provides for the amnesty period for eligible chemicals to be prescribed by regulation.

The amendment omits reference to prescription by regulation and specifies a period of two years for the amnesty.
