EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Amendment) Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to enable a summons for an offence under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979 to be served by post by an officer under that Act.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 amends section 63 (Manner of service of summons) of the Principal Act so as to enable an officer under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979 to serve a summons for an offence under that Act by post.
