

TOW TRUCK INDUSTRY (REVOCAION OF PROCLAMATION) BILL 1988

NEW SOUTH WALES



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to revoke a proclamation commencing provisions of the Tow Truck Industry Act 1987; and
- (b) to make provision consequent on the revocation of the proclamation.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will commence on the date of its assent.

Clause 3 revokes a proclamation under section 2 of the Principal Act (being a proclamation that provides for the commencement of provisions of that Act) and provides that the proclamation shall be taken never to have been made. The clause saves anything else done or omitted under the Principal Act before the date of assent to the proposed Act and ensures that a further proclamation can be made to commence the provisions of the Principal Act.
